

Dentistry On Monroe COVID Precautions

Here at Dentistry On Monroe, we take many precautions to ensure your safety while you're in our care. Dr. Turner built the practice in the initial phase of the pandemic, allowing him to put the following measures in place to protect your health during your visit:

SecureAire

Every 6-10 minutes, the air in our practice is cleaned and renewed by the SecureAire system – A particle filtration system built into our airducts that is constantly running. Originally built for hospital operating rooms, SecureAire uses active particle filtration and neutralization to remove airborne pathogens and harmful chemical compounds from the air at Dentistry On Monroe.

Respirator Masks

Our clinical staff wear respirator facemasks that surpass the standard for N95 fit tests. The respirator allows Dr. Turner and his clinical staff to use N95 filters in a reusable, washable frame. These masks prevent transmission of harmful particles between you and our staff during procedures.

Clinical Uniforms Kept On-Site

The uniforms worn by Dr. Turner and his clinical staff are never worn outside of the office. They are stored and washed in our practice every day!

Appointment Staggering

As an office that focuses on quality over speed, we are able to stagger our appointments between treatment rooms. This means that you can be sure the room you're in for your visit has been properly cleaned, and that the disinfection agents have had time to finish killing pathogens on treatment surfaces. Furthermore, our SecureAire system will have had ample time to filter, clean, and renew the air in the treatment room many times before the room is occupied again.

Hand Sanitizer Stations

Hand sanitizer stations are present entering into the clinical area, and at the entrance of all treatment rooms. They are used before, during, and after each procedure. You can be sure that when you're here, you're in good CLEAN hands.

COVID Questionnaire

All of our patients receive a COVID questionnaire 24 hours before their appointment. If the responses to the questions indicate possible exposure or illness within the last 2 weeks, their appointment is rescheduled.

Temperature Checks

Upon arrival, patients have their temperature taken upon arrival with an infrared thermometer. If a patient has a temperature above 100.0, their appointment is rescheduled.

Reception Area Closed

Until the spread of the novel Coronavirus is reliably under control, the reception area at Dentistry On Monroe will remain closed to anyone waiting for their appointment. Upon arrival, our patients are asked to remain in their car until the clinical staff is ready to begin their appointment.
